### **Profile**

The Busker Triple Cask Triple Smooth is a beautiful yellow, gold-colored whiskey. It is full, with an unmistakable rich body. The nose often leads off with tropical fruits and vanilla notes. The journey continues with notes of malt, sweetness, and dark chocolate, while more subtle notes of toffee fudge and cinnamon, add intensity. The whiskey concludes with a mellow, well balanced, sweet finish.

### **Production Technique**

Here we blend a high percentage of our triple distilled Single Malt & Single Pot Still with our column distilled Single Grain, to bring you a combination of the full traditional taste that Ireland has to offer. These exquisite spirits have been matured and finished in Bourbon casks, Sherry casks, and Marsala casks to bring you that smoothness we want.
